





#### Introduction

The New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) is committed to supporting our residents by offering opportunities to further their education and make a difference for themselves, their families and their communities.

On behalf of PHADA the Public Housing Authority Directors Association and NYSPHADA the New York State branch of the Directors Association, NYCHA is pleased to inform its residents and Section 8 recipients of an opportunity to apply for college scholarships ranging from \$1,000 up to \$7,000.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

Scholarship applicants must:

- ✓ Be an authorized NYCHA resident or Section 8 recipient
- ✓ Be a high school senior preparing to enter higher level learning (defined as a 2-4 year college, trade school or formal certification program)
- ✓ Have a minimum B grade point average
- ✓ Submit the required essays
- ✓ Submit the required recommendations
- ✓ Submit an original high school transcript

#### **Application Process**

There are two scholarship applications. Please review the application instructions carefully. Incomplete application packages that do not meet the requirements will not be considered. - The scholarship application fee will be paid by NYCHA. Do not send any money with your application.
- Please leave blank any section for "Executive Director"
- Please sign and date the application. Applications that are not signed and dated may be disqualified.

#### **Selection Process**

NYCHA representatives will screen all application packages and select eligible applicants *to be nominated* to the PHADA and NYSPHADA Scholarship Programs respectively. NYCHA can nominate up to two applicants per scholarship program. NYCHA is not involved in selecting a final scholarship recipient.

Students who are selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by PHADA and NYSPHADA directly. Awards will be made in April and May 2013.

#### **Award Amount**

NYSPHADA Scholarship: \$1,000.00

PHADA – HD Supply Scholarship: \$5,000

PHADA – Freedom and Civil Rights Scholarship: \$5,000 PHADA – Stephen J. Bollinger Memorial Scholarship: \$7,000

Deadline: January 14, 2013

Applications must be completed and postmarked or faxed to NYCHA no later than **January 14, 2013**.

Even though a different deadline appears on the scholarship application, **please** submit your package to NYCHA by January 14, 2013. Late submissions will not be considered. The later date listed on the application is the deadline by which NYCHA must submit its nominations.

## **Scholarship Program**

In order to encourage academic excellence and community responsibility among high school students, NYSPHADA has implemented a scholarship program for graduating seniors who are preparing to enter higher level learning (defined as a 2-4 year college, trade school or formal certification program). NYSPHADA will award one (1) scholarship to a deserving youth currently residing in a NYSPHADA member agency.

This scholarship will be formally presented at NYSPHADA's Annual Conference and Exhibition on April 16, 2013 at the Turning Stone Casino & Resort in Verona, New York. The winner will receive travel accommodations for him/herself and one parent/guardian to attend the conference.

The scholarship fund will be administered by the NYSPHADA Scholarship Committee. The money will go directly to the school that the recipient will be attending. The school will deposit the money into the student's account. The money may only be used to pay for tuition, books, and activities directly related to the student's education. If the student discontinues his or her education, the unused portion of the scholarship will be returned to NYSPHADA.

## **Eligibility Checklist**

☐ <u>Status</u> – Applicant must be a <b>high school senior and reside in a NYSPHADA member agency</b> owned or
managed unit throughout his/her entire senior year. Public housing residents, Section 8 participants or other
low-income housing residents are eligible, as long as the agency at which they reside is a NYSPHADA member.
☐ Minimum Grade Point Average - Student must have at least a "B" average on his/her school's
applicable scale during his/her high school career, cumulatively, to be considered for the scholarship.

For consideration of this scholarship, applications must be completed in their entirety.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

NOTE: School counselor must complete the Grade Point Average Verification form on the verification page of

this application.
